Per MCL 257.722 (6c) use of restricted roads during weight restrictions will be minimized and only utilized when necessary to perform work using the public utility vehicle or vehicle configuration and that nonrestricted roads shall be used for travel when available for route travel. Maximum speed on weight restricted roads shall be 35 mph.

Permittee must notify the Clinton County Road Commission by fax, or electronically if pre-arranged, with at least 24 hours prior to movement unless approved by an authorized representative of the Clinton County Road Commission.

REMINDER: THIS PERMIT APPROVED FOR LEGAL AXLE LOADS ONLY

Maximum load on any wheel shall not exceed 700 pounds per inch of tire width.

All movements using Clinton County Road Commission roads shall utilize All Season Roads and Class A roads(to the nearest intersection of the point of destination) before using Class B county roads to reach destinations located on Class B roads, unless otherwise approved.

**SEASONAL PUBLIC UTILITY NON-EMERGENCY EXEMPTION PERMIT
RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. The driver of the vehicle shall carry this permit in the vehicle to which it applies and shall have it available for inspection by any police officer or agent of the Clinton County Road Commission (CCRC) or Michigan State Police Motor Carrier Officer.
2. Applicant shall be responsible for any damage caused to wires, mailboxes, and trees on the roadway, and shall reimburse the owners or persons in charge for any property damage caused by the moving of said vehicle or load, and shall save harmless and indemnify the "Clinton County Road Commission, commissioners, and employees" from all suits, damages, and proceedings of every kind arising out of the presence on and use of the roadway of said vehicle and load.
3. The speed of the vehicle shall not exceed that shown on this permit and load **shall not exceed normal legal axle loading**. Divisible loads must still meet the seasonal load restriction requirements and are not exempt as part of this permit.
4. Vehicles shall be registered as required by the Michigan statutes and will not violate any statute or valid ordinance, rule, or regulation by any state agency or sub-division of the state.
5. Vehicles are to comply with all statutory provisions as to other permits, licensing, motor vehicle equipment, and operation, including properly secured loads.
6. Permits will in no way supersede posted axle loading limits on any bridge, culvert or roadway. The applicant agrees to reimburse the CCRC for any damage resulting from the disregard of such postings.
7. The vehicle shall not be loaded or unloaded within the outer shoulder limits of any county road.
8. Permits are invalidated automatically by violation of any of the conditions specified by the terms of the permit by false information given on the application.
9. Failure to comply with the conditions of this permit shall be just cause for the immediate suspension or revocation of any or all permits and the operator and/or owner of the vehicle may be subject to arrest.
10. Weather conditions may require temporary suspension of right-of-way work and use of this permit
11. Permits are not valid if insurance expires. Applicant to present evidence that insurance coverage is in full force and effect on each vehicle while operating on the public roadways under special permit.
