The undersigned proposes to furnish gravel to the Board of Clinton County Road Commissioners in accordance with the requirements of the current Edition of the Michigan Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Construction and the following specifications:

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

The processed gravel will be 23A modified and 22A, meeting the Michigan Department of Transportation's specifications with the following exceptions:

- 1- Class II Sand - None
- 2- 22A – If the percent passing the no. 8 sieve is 40-50%, then the loss by wash shall be 6-8%.
- 3- 23A Modified – The percent passing the no. 8 sieve shall be 25-56%, the loss by wash shall be 8-12%.
- 4- 21AA – None
- 5- Crushed Concrete -None

No additional modifications of the specifications will be made without the permission of the Managing Director of the Clinton County Road Commission. Materials will be approved prior to pickup. The undersigned will be responsible for testing material to guarantee specification compliance. If deemed necessary by the Clinton County Road Commission, an independent firm can be retained for testing of materials with the cost to be shared equally by the Road Commission and the supplier. The Clinton County Road Commission reserves the right to have a certified testing lab sample material from the grade and test for specification compliance at any time.

Prices are to be firm through 2018.

The material shall be available for pickup and loaded into road commission trucks at bidder's stockpile.

The unit price shall be on a "per ton" basis. Measurement shall be by weight tickets. All material shall be weighed on State certified platform scales.

The intent is to have Clinton County Road Commission trucks loaded with various materials at various locations throughout Clinton County for miscellaneous maintenance operations.

The Road Commission reserves the right to accept any part or this entire bid that they feel is in the best interest of the road commission.

Renewal Option:

The Road Commission reserves the right to renew the contract for additional one-year terms. Each renewal to be mutually agreed upon by both parties. Pricing, terms and conditions of the first year of the contract will remain the same for any subsequent one-year renewal period.

PAYMENT

Payment will be made **30 days** from the invoice date pending Road Commission approval.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Contractors working within the road right-of-way must have valid certificate of Workers' Compensation Disability Insurance and Liability Insurance naming the "Clinton County Road Commission its Commissioners and Employees" as "additional insured" and shall be on file at the Road Commission office before work begins. Minimum requirements are:

Auto Liability Owned & Non-owned	\$1,000,000 Bodily Injury/Property Damage including statutory Michigan No-Fault and Uninsured Motorists
General Liability	\$1,000,000 Bodily Injury - each person \$1,000,000 Bodily Injury – each accident \$1,000,000 Property Damage – each accident \$1,000,000 Single Limit Policy
Workers' Compensation	Statutory coverage

Should the policy cancel or expire, all activities authorized by this agreement shall cease. The award will be made on an individual township basis after the commission has received approval from that township.
