All materials are to meet the current Michigan Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction and may be tested by a private testing laboratory designated by the Clinton County Road Commission. Costs of the authorized testing shall be borne by the Clinton County Road Commission.

Liquid asphalt material must be delivered, when delivery is requested, to our distributor at any point within Clinton County at temperatures which would require no additional heating for spreading. Deliveries must be made in a minimum of 5,000-gallon quantities. Bid prices for liquid asphalt are to be based on a unit price per gallon @ 60° F.

The bidder will be responsible for CDL compliance of any and all employees/sub-contractors used in fulfilling the asphalt emulsion transport.

Renewal Option:

The road commission reserves the right to renew the contract for additional one-year terms. Each renewal is to be mutually agreed upon by both parties. Pricing, terms and conditions of the first year of the contract will remain the same for any subsequent one-year renewal period.
