Sealed bids will be opened at **10:00 am on February 21, 2018** by the Clinton County Road Commission at its office for furnishing its 2018 Annual Requirements of Open-graded Polymer Emulsion Patch Mixes CP-6 - Stylink. All materials are to meet the current Michigan Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Construction and may be tested by a private testing laboratory, designated by the Road Commission (at the Road Commissions expense).

Bid prices are to be indicated on this sheet and **submitted in a sealed envelope marked "COLD PATCH" and shall include the name and address of the bidder.**

Bid prices are to be firm for 2018.

Bid prices are to be based on CP-6 Stylink and UPM material per ton delivered to our Clinton County facility located at 3536 South US Highway 27, St. Johns, Michigan.

All materials are to meet the current Michigan Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Construction and may be tested by a private testing laboratory, designated by the Road Commission (at the Road Commission's expense).

The bidder will be responsible for CDL compliance of any and all employees/sub-contractors used in fulfilling the CP-6 Stylink and UPM material delivery.

The Road Commission reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to accept the bid which is, in its opinion, in the best interest of the Clinton County Road Commission.

Renewal Option:

The Road Commission reserves the right to renew the contract for additional one-year terms. Each renewal is to be mutually agreed upon by both parties. Pricing, terms and conditions of the first year of the contract will remain the same for any subsequent one-year renewal period.
