The undersigned proposes to furnish gravel to the Board of Clinton County Road Commissioners in accordance with the requirements of the current Edition of the Michigan Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Construction and the following specifications:

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Loading & Trucking only – 22A / 23A Gravel from the various pits located in Greenbush and Duplain Townships and the Piggott pit located on Wright Road in Lebanon Township, Lyons Township in Ionia County and Middlebury Township in Shiawassee County to various locations throughout Clinton County.

The bidder will be responsible for CDL compliance of any and all employees/sub-contractors used in fulfilling the gravel transport.

Prices are to be firm through December 1, 2018.

The undersigned has included a listing of three references of previous work experience including the company name, address, phone number, and contact person.

LOCATION AND QUANTITY

The material shall be delivered to the roads designated by the Road Commission for each township. The delivery of a minimum of 2,000 ton per 10-hour day will be required. If not, the operation will be shut down until the contractor can show that this can be accomplished. All trucks must be able to spread the material in a uniform and consistent depth. No stockpiling of material.

The unit price shall be on a "per ton" basis. Measurement shall be by loader scales. Material will be loaded by bidder. The estimated amount of gravel to be hauled for the County will be approximately 70,000 tons more or less.

DEAD ENDS

Spot Application definition: Spot applications will be no less than 20 ton per location. Also, roads that are dead ends and/or with restricted load limits.

TIME OF DELIVERY

The bidder will work in conjunction with the Road Commission to determine the date of delivery. Also, notice of intent to deliver will be required by 3:30 p.m. the day prior to delivery. This is to give the Road Commission time for preparation of the road surface and to have a grader available to level the material. If no material has arrived at the job site by 7:00 a.m., the grader will be removed from the project and no material will be placed that day.

PAYMENT

Payment will be made 30 days from the invoice date pending Road Commission approval.

COMPLETION DATE

All material shall be delivered and spread by October 1, 2018. If this is not met a **\$500.00/day** penalty will be accessed.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Contractors working within the road right-of-way must have valid certificate of Workers' Compensation Disability Insurance and Liability Insurance naming the "Clinton County Road Commission its Commissioners and Employees" as "additional insured" and shall be on file at the Road Commission office before work begins. Minimum requirements are:

General Liability	\$1,000,000 Bodily Injury - each person \$1,000,000 Bodily Injury – each accident \$1,000,000 Property Damage – each accident \$1,000,000 Single Limit Policy
Workers' Compensation	Statutory coverage

Should the policy be canceled or expire, all activities authorized by this agreement shall cease.
The award will be made on an individual township basis after the commission has received approval from that township.

Renewal Option:

The Road Commission reserves the right to renew the contract for additional one-year terms. Each renewal to be mutually agreed upon by both parties. Pricing, terms and conditions of the first year of the contract will remain the same for any subsequent one-year renewal period

The Road Commission reserves the right to accept any part or this entire bid that they feel is in the best interest of the road commission.
