ITEM: To furnish, mix and load the Clinton County Road Commission, 2018 annual requirements of bituminous hot patching material #1100 T 20AA or other bituminous mixtures as approved by the Road Commission. (13A and 36A)

Bituminous hot patching material #1100 T 20AA, 13A and 36A shall meet the material requirement and other requirements of the current Standard Specifications for Construction of the Michigan Department of Transportation.

The estimate total for plant pickup is 1,000 tons, more or less for all mixtures.

The undersigned has examined the specifications described herein and understands that the quantities shown are approximate only and are subject to either increase or decrease.

The bituminous hot patching material shall utilize PG 58-28. The mixture proportions shall vary as directed by the Clinton County Road Commission.

The pay weights shall be determined by weighing the mix in the trucks on approved platform scales with the weigh person being provided by the successful bidder.

Payment:

Payment will be made 30 days from the invoice date pending road commission approval.

Renewal Option:

The Road Commission reserves the right to renew the contract for one additional one-year terms. Each renewal to be mutually agreed upon by both parties. Pricing, terms and conditions of the first year of the contract will remain the same for any subsequent one-year renewal period.

The Board of the Clinton County Road Commissioners shall have the right to reject any or all bids and to accept the bid that is in their opinion the best interest of the Road Commission.
