BITUMINOUS MIXTURE SKIP PATCH BID

Sealed Bids will be received at the office of the Clinton County Road Commission at 3536 S. US Highway 27, St. Johns, Michigan, until **10:00 am on February 21, 2018** for **Bituminous Mixture Skip Patch**.

Asphalt skip patches will be a minimum of 40 ton per location with option of 20 ton, 20-22 feet wide and paved at an approximate rate of 180-220 lbs. / syd. as directed by the project engineer. Bond coat shall be applied as directed by the project engineer and the cost shall be included in the price per ton of the bituminous material. Temporary pavement marking shall be placed immediately on skip patching and the cost shall be included in the price per ton of the bituminous material.

The undersigned hereby proposes to furnish all necessary machinery, tools, apparatus, and other means of construction, do all the work, furnish all the materials, and for the unit prices named in the itemized bid, to complete the work herein described in strict accordance with the plans therefore and in strict conformity with the requirements of the current edition of the MDOT Specifications for Construction and any attached supplemental specifications that may be a part of this bid.

The bidder will be responsible for CDL compliance of any and all employees/subcontractors used in fulfilling the skip patch operations as specified in this document.

SUPPLEMENTAL SPECIFICATONS

A minimum of one roller, per paver, shall be required on the project and the material shall be rolled as directed by the engineer. Vibratory roller will be permitted for compaction purposes.

Bituminous Mixture Course #13A or 1100T will be paid for at the price per ton, which shall be payment in full for furnishing and heating the materials, mixing, hauling, spreading and compacting the mixture to the satisfaction of the engineer.

The #13A or 1100T Bituminous Mixture shall utilize PG 58-28 liquid asphalt cement with 3% air voids per MDOT Specifications.

Prior to the beginning of production, the contractor shall submit a mix design for the Road Commission engineer's approval.

BITUMINOUS MATERIAL INSPECTION

Bituminous materials used on this project shall be tested by a private testing laboratory designated by the Clinton County Road Commission. Costs of the authorized testing shall be borne by the Clinton County Road Commission.

The bituminous mixture shall meet the requirements as set forth in the current MDOT Specifications.

SUBCONTRACTING

The approval of the Clinton County Road Commission shall be obtained before naming a subcontractor for any substantial amount of work. The contractor shall assure himself that any subcontractor named has sufficient equipment, insurance and personnel to properly complete any item of work within specified time.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Contractors working within the road right-of-way must have a valid certificate of Workers Compensation Disability Insurance and Liability Insurance naming the Clinton County Road Commission, Employees, and Commissioners as "additional insured" and shall be on file at the road commission office before work begins. Minimum requirements are:

<i>Auto Liability</i> <i>Owned & Non-owned</i>	\$1,000,000 Bodily Injury/Property Damage including statutory Michigan No-Fault and Uninsured Motorists
<i>General Liability</i>	\$1,000,000 Bodily Injury - each person \$1,000,000 Bodily Injury – each accident \$1,000,000 Property Damage – each accident \$1,000,000 Single Limit Policy
<i>Workers' Compensation</i>	Statutory coverage

MAINTAINING TRAFFIC

Reasonable access for property owners along the streets under construction will be required. The contractor shall conduct his operations in such a manner that a minimum amount of inconvenience to the property owner shall be suffered.

Flag persons shall be required.

The contractor shall be required to place a minimum of one advance warning sign prior to each end of the project. The signs may read "Construction Ahead", "Men Working" or some other legend meeting the approval of the engineer.

PRECONSTRUCTION MEETING

A pre-construction meeting with a representative from each party is required prior to the start of any construction.

RENEWAL OPTION

The Road Commission reserves the right to renew the contract for additional one-year terms. Each renewal is to be mutually agreed upon by both parties. Pricing, terms, and conditions of the first contract will remain the same for any subsequent one-year renewal period.

PAYMENT

Work on the project is considered complete upon placement of the bituminous mix and temporary pavement markings at paving only locations. A pay estimate will be prepared on the 1st and 3rd Monday of each month after an itemized bill has been received from the bidder covering the work completed on the project. Retainage will be in accordance with MDOT Specifications. Payments will be processed on the second and fourth Thursday of each month or at scheduled Road Commission Board meetings after approval. **Payment will be made 30 days from the invoice date pending Road Commission approval.**

The Board of the Clinton County Road Commissioners reserves the right to accept or reject any part or all bids and to accept the bid that is in their opinion in the best interest of the Road Commission.
