

Clinton County Road Commission seeks a Managing Director as of January 7, 2019

The Clinton County Road Commission (CCRC) is seeking a Managing Director due to the upcoming retirement of the current Managing Director. The CCRC is a 44 person organization that has been serving the community for 106 years and is very proud of a road system of nearly 1,200 miles.

The Managing Director reports directly to a three person Board of Road Commissioners that are members of the community. The CCRC's annual motor transportation fund revenue has increased dramatically in recent years and is currently projected at \$11 million annually. In addition to the county road system the CCRC also performs maintenance on the State Highway system, 242 lane miles. The CCRC has one location that houses both the road maintenance facilities and the administrative offices, there are no satellite facilities.

The ideal candidate will be a leader who has a successful history of leading engineering, road maintenance or construction management organizations. A bachelor's degree is preferred in public administration, civil engineering, construction management or related fields. Strong financial management, interpersonal skills and working within a union setting is desired.
