MINUTES:

The minutes of the January 10, 2018 regular meeting were reviewed. It was moved by Commissioner Watkins, seconded by Commissioner Blauwiekel, and passed unanimously, to approve the January 10, 2018 regular meeting minutes as presented.

AGENDA:

It was moved by Commissioner Watkins, seconded by Commissioner Blauwiekel, and passed unanimously, to approve the Agenda as printed.

COMMUNICATIONS:

The following communications were reviewed: 1) Contract Services Agreement with Michigan State Police, 2) MCRCSIP 2017 Battery Disconnect Mandate, 3) MCRCSIP Notice of Refund due to change to fire protection classification, 4) MDOT email notice of Act 51 Distribution of \$175 Million, 5) 2018 Materials/Services/Equipment Bid List (Bids taken on 2/21/18), 6) 2018 township Meeting Schedule, 7) MDOT 2017 Maintenance Advance – Due to MDOT, 8) D/C Engineering Contract for design of water/sewer project for Clinton County Road Commission main facility. It was moved by Commissioner Watkins, seconded by Commissioner Blauwiekel, and passed unanimously, to accept and place the communications on file.

INFORMATION FROM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

County Commissioner Washburn reported: 1) Still working to get an additional seat at Tri-County Regional Planning, 2) Approved the Clinton Transit Budget at 1.6 million, he explained that the County approves the Transit Authority budget as it was set up that the Board must approve budget and millage requests when the Transit Authority was formed, 3) A new Committee has been formed to keep the Board up to date on zoning issues.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

There was no public comment.

STAFF REPORTS:

Mr. Armentrout reported on the following 2018 Federal Aid projects: Clark Road – Airport to DeWitt Road and Herbison – Schavey to Turner will be in the March letting. Grove Road over the Stony Creek: Nashville Construction has moved in and will begin removing the deck this week. Colony – DeWitt to Forest Hill with preventative maintenance on three bridges: Rieth Riley was the low bidder, construction scheduled to begin in May. Colony-Scott to Williams: construction is scheduled to begin in September. Federal Chip seal projects are planned as follows: Jones-Eaton Highway to Grand River, Wacousta-Grand River to Howe, Grange-Howe to Jason, Wright-Herbison to Pratt. He also reviewed the 2020 Herbison, Airport and bridge projects. County paving prices came in a little higher on main line, subdivisions stayed relatively even.

WHEREAS, this contract is for PART B: Rehabilitation work for structures #1907; #1908; and #1909, which carry Colony Road over the South Fork of Hayworth Creek, Sections 28, 33, 34, 26, & 25, T08N, R03W, Essex Township, Clinton County, Michigan; including hot mix asphalt resurfacing bridge railing thrie beam retrofit, membrane preformed waterproofing, approach, and maintaining traffic work; and all together with necessary related work; and

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Road Commission has approved participation in their share of this project,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Chairperson Peter Blauwiekel and Director of Finance/Clerk Jill Rey be authorized and instructed to sign the contract for and on behalf of the Clinton County Road Commission.

WHEREAS, this contract is for PART B: Hot mix asphalt cold milling and overlay work along Herbison Road from Schavey Road easterly to Turner Road; including concrete curb repair, drainage structure repair, and concrete sidewalk ramp work; and all together with necessary related work; and

WHEREAS, this contract is for PART C: Non-motorized path construction work along Herbison Road from Panther Drive easterly to Turner Road connecting to existing path at DeWitt Sports Park; and all together with necessary related work; and

WHEREAS, the contract is for PART D: Non-motorized path construction work along Clark Road from Airport Road easterly to Panther Drive; and all together with necessary related work; and

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Road Commission has approved participation in their share of this project,
