G. Engineering Report

Mr. Trotter Reported:

Design:

- · Webster Road -
- We adjusted the design to fit in the ROW, as we were not able to reach an agreement with three of the landowners before the turn in date for the May letting.
 - The anticipated start date is mid-June.

- Chandler Rd from Parks to M-21-
- We received confirmation from MDOT on a March letting, with September construction.
- · We will do the county culvert project ahead of the Federal Aid portion of the project.

Airport Road -

• Since we have not received any update from EGLE on potential funding, we are now planning for construction in 2025 instead of 2024.

Bridges & Culverts

- Dexter Trail over Muskrat Creek -
- The design is complete and ready for bid posting.
- Kinley over the Peets Creek -
- Lebanon Township requested to move forward with the cost estimates and final design.
- Spicer confirmed with MDOT that the crossing can be reopened with reduced load posting in the 10-ton range, along with routine monitoring.
 - · Jason over the Morris Creek -
 - · Westphalia Township has requested to move forward with design.
 - · Anderson over the Swagert Drain -
- Spicer confirmed with MDOT that the slope repair does not have a mandatory deadline, so the single lane restriction can remain in place until the repairs are complete.
 - · Hyde over Cox Drain -
- CCRC plans to post bids for a metal culvert purchase, this will be installed by CCRC with as-needed excavator support.

Planning:

- Our 2023 Asset Management Plans are complete & have been accepted by MDOT.
- We received the MDOT contracts for the Chandler Road earmark project, as well as the MEDC agreement for the DeWitt Road earmark project; we will post the RFP for both in February.

ROW - Permits - Developments:

• BR-27 & Twinbrook -

- The developer submitted revised plans to MDOT on January 18th but did not include or request comment from CCRC.
 - MDOT, DeWitt Township, and CCRC met on January 29th to discuss access along BR-27.
- MDOT is supportive of a commercial drive with a right-in/right-out on BR-27. Left turns (in/out) will not be allowed at the commercial drive.
- MDOT stated they may issue a tentative approval letter prior to the FHWA approval, if necessary for CCRC's approval process.
- A traffic signal will not be allowed at the commercial drive. However, MDOT is supportive of a signal located at BR-27 & Twinbrook. This would be installed by the developer. The developer needs to submit an updated plan to CCRC based on the current input from MDOT.

H. Director of Finance Report

Ms. Gurski reported:

- MTF for February (December fuel) was \$1,429,646.56.
- We received communication from MDOT that there was an error with the Capital Equipment Advance calculations they sent to out December. The 2020 five-year avg. equipment usage ratio was inadvertently used in 2021, so correcting that adjusted what we owed to MDOT by \$7,482 more.
- We have had some requests recently for use of our board room, so we put together a 'board room use' waiver/guidelines to cover potential damage/incidentals and protect CCRC from liability.
- We hosted the Southern MI Road Commission Finance & HR Association meeting yesterday.
- I have been working with Thatch Computer Consulting to implement measures to increase our network security.
- Continuing to work through year end & preparing for audit.
- Entering the ACT 51 information into the ADARS system.

- Mark Wineland who currently works in our sign shop and has been with the road commission for 26 years, will be retiring in March.
- Continuing to work with townships on 2024 projects.
- In the process of setting up the Legislative Breakfast and figuring out a date that will work best for legislators.
- Working on the final closeout of new building, Brivar did issue the final pay app, but we need a credit back yet on some items.
- Attended the Engineers conference last week in Manistee with Marc and Jake.
- We received our two new plow trucks, as well as the patch trailers.
- The US 127 construction near Frandor, will be starting in March.
